PROJECT OVERVIEW

To authorize the sale of alcoholic beverages (beer, wine, and distilled spirits) for off-site consumption, with an upgrade from a Type 20 California Department of Alcohol Beverage Control ("ABC") License to a Type 21 ABC License, at an existing grocery market currently doing business as El Zorro Market. The market is approximately 4,492 square feet in size and consists of a meat sales counter, food preparation area, walk-in cooler/freezer, storage spaces, in addition to the primary retail space.

The grocery market is currently deemed-approved for the sale of alcoholic beverages (beer and wine) for off-site consumption with a Type 20 ABC License. This CUP would add distilled spirits to the existing offerings by upgrading the ABC License classification.

Staff recommends that the alcohol sales hours be from 10:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. daily, while the market currently operates from 8:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. daily.
