## **PROJECT DESCRIPTION**

#### A. Entitlement Requested

Oak Tree Permit ("OTP") to authorize the removal of one heritage-sized oak tree, associated with the construction of two single-family residences and an accessory dwelling unit ("Project") in the R-1-7,500 (Single-Family Residence - 7,500 Square Feet Minimum Required Lot Area) Zone pursuant to <u>County Code Section 22.174.030</u> (Applicability). Approval of the residential development will be ministerially reviewed under Senate Bill 9 and under a separate Site Plan Review No. RPPL2024002158.

## B. Recommendation to Take Agenda Item No. 6 Off Calendar

The Applicant requests additional time to explore other design options to avoid the removal of the heritage-sized oak tree. Staff recommends that the Hearing Officer take the matter off calendar until such time as the Applicant is ready to continue with the case.
