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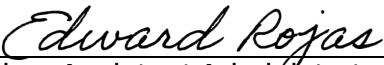

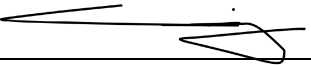
UPDATE TO THE LOS ANGELES COUNTY AIRPORT LAND USE PLAN On November 5, 2025, staff will introduce the effort currently underway to update the Los Angeles County Airport Land Use Plan (“ALUP”). The current ALUP was adopted in 1991 and revised in 2004. California State Law requires the creation of an Airport Land Use Commission (“ALUC”) to coordinate planning and land use activities for the areas surrounding public use airports. The ALUC has no jurisdiction over airport operations or the zoning regulations for land uses in areas surrounding airports.

This presentation will provide an overview of the ALUP update, which consists of two parts: 1) to revise the Los Angeles County Airport Land Use Commission Review Procedures , which are used to review and determine consistency for aviation projects; and 2) to amend the plan to include the Airport Influence Area (“AIA”) of Cable Airport, which is located in the City of Upland within the County of San Bernadino. Additionally, this presentation will include a summary of the role of the ALUC in implementing the ALUP.

This presentation is intended to be an informative overview of the update to the ALUP, no action is required.
